LACMA CLOSES TIM BURTON WITH CELEBRATORY WEEKEND

WHAT:

The Los Angeles County Museum of Art (LACMA) hosts a celebratory weekend to close its presentation of *Tim Burton*, a major retrospective exploring the full range of Tim Burton's work.

The weekend will provide extended museum hours from 10 am on Sunday, October 30 through midnight on Monday, October 31—in addition to family programming, gallery conversations, a Vincent Price film marathon, and the 8th Annual Muse Costume Ball.

WHO:

On Saturday, October 29, programming will include Storytelling Performance: Pumpkin Bones, Picnic Stones, and Hallow's Eve Tales for families and Conversations in Burton Selects: From LACMA's Collection led by Gallery Educators. From 8:30 pm-12:30 am, LACMA Muse will host the annual Costume Ball featuring performances from 25-piece experimental jazz orchestra Killsonic, DJ Jeremiah Red, and collective Sneaky Nietzsche, with environments created by Labyrinth of Jareth.

On Sunday, October 30, family programming will include **Andell Family Sundays—Tim Burton: What a Character!**—an artist-led workshop where families can design costumes, make puppets, and participate in a puppet show. Beginning at 1 pm, LACMA will screen six free Halloween classic films back to back, all starring Tim Burton's idol, Vincent Price, in honor of his centenary.
